Bayside Christian College provides scholarships to appropriately qualified students in the areas of:

Academic Achievement
Music and Performing Arts
Community Service

Availability and Requirements of Scholarships

- Scholarships are offered at the beginning of each school year with application made via the Administration office or by mail.
- Current students are eligible to apply for scholarships
- The decision to award a scholarship is entirely at the Principal's discretion.
- Names of scholarship holders will not be published.
- Academic Scholarships are generally offered on the basis of documented certification of achievement. Copies of reports and certificates must be provided.
- Music Scholarships are generally offered on the basis of an application and documented certification by a registered authority of level achieved. Audition may be required.
- Community Service Scholarships are offered to students who can show exceptional involvement in the community on an ongoing basis.
- Sport Scholarships are offered on the basis that students have competed at a regional, or state level. Documentation of achievement needs to be supplied by a recognised independent membership body.
- As well as excellence in specific areas, **students must have exemplary behaviour**, be of good character and wear the school uniform to the highest standard both within the school and the community. Failure to meet this requirement is terms for cancellation of the scholarship.
- It is also expected that all other student fees, not covered by the scholarship, are paid within the required timeframes. Failure to meet this requirement are terms for cancellation of the scholarship.

Value of scholarships

- All scholarships offer full or partial remission of base tuition fees only.
- The value of a scholarship is entirely at the Principal's discretion.
- If a student is successful in two scholarship areas (e.g. academic and music), a 'bundled' scholarship offer may be made.
- Scholarship holders receive normal sibling fee discounts, if applicable.
- Bursaries may be made available under exceptional circumstances, at the Principal's discretion.

Duration of scholarships

- The tenure of a scholarship will be to the end of the school year applied for only.
- A new application must be made in full for each year.
- A scholarship offer may not be deferred. If a student is not in a position to take up a scholarship in the year offered, they must reapply the following year.
- All scholarships are reviewed annually.
